The recessed meeting was called to order by Board President Hank Florey.

A motion by Supervisor Craig Hitt, seconded by Supervisor Hank Florey, to approve the "Agenda" for even date, was passed unanimously.

Prayer was offered by Supervisor Craig Hitt.

Mr. Jimmy Slay, Lauderdale County Tax Assessor, made a recommendation to the Board regarding the assessed value of Mar-Ray, Inc. properties, to stand as presented earlier since Dr. White did not provide the information that was previously requested. Board Attorney, Rick Barry, informed the Board that they need to make a decision on the 2008 assessed value as of this date.

A discussion of the Linton Property – PPIN 2022 for the 2008 Assessed Value was discussed at this time. The home's value increased from \$94,530 in 2007 to \$164,470 in 2008. Board Attorney, Rick Barry, informed the Board that they need to make a decision on the 2008 assessed value as of this date.

A motion by Supervisor Hank Florey, seconded by Supervisor Craig Hitt, to divide the difference between the Tax Appraised Value on Mar-Ray Apartments of \$2,387,930 (PPIN #030259, 030260 and 030261) and their Appraisal Value of \$1,515,000 – for a total of \$1,951,465 for Assessed Value for 2008, was passed unanimously.

SO ORDERED, this August 28, 2009.

A motion by Supervisor Hank Florey, seconded by Supervisor Craig Hitt, to divide the difference between the Tax Appraised Value on PPIN #013666 – 1602 Northwood Street

of \$91,870 and their Appraisal Value of \$74,000 – for a total of \$\$82,935 for Assessed Value for 2008, was passed unanimously.

SO ORDERED, this August 28, 2009.

A motion by Supervisor Hank Florey, seconded by Supervisor Craig Hitt, to divide the difference between the Tax Appraised Value on PPIN #004572 – 3419 40th Street of \$73,130 and their Appraisal Value of \$62,000 – for a total of \$67,565 for Assessed Value for 2008, was passed unanimously.

SO ORDERED, this August 28, 2009.

A motion by Supervisor Hank Florey, seconded by Supervisor Craig Hitt, to divide the difference between the Tax Appraised Value on PPIN #013677 – 3707 Oakdale Avenue of \$\$90,320 and their Appraisal Value of \$76,000 – for a total of \$83,160 for Assessed Value for 2008, was passed unanimously.

A motion by Supervisor Ray Boswell, seconded by Supervisor Craig Hitt, to accept the recommendation of the Tax Assessor for the 2008 Revised Assessed Value on PPIN #2022 (Linton's House) of \$123,440 (originally \$164,470); and PPIN #43394 (Linton Lot) of \$1,700 (originally \$5,100), was passed unanimously.
