A. OVERVIEW

Lauderdale County, MS (the "County") request bids from qualified, licensed contractors to recycle (crush) existing concrete stockpile at the Old Village Fair Mall located at 610 22nd Avenue Meridian, MS. Subject to the terms, conditions, provisions, and the enclosed specifications, responses to this solicitation will be received at this office until the stated date and time. Responses received after the scheduled due date and time will be rejected. B. SCOPE OF WORK

The project consists of recycling (crushing) existing concrete stockpile at the Old Village Fair Mall facility. The pile is assumed to contain 25,000 tons of material. The material will be crushed to 1-1/2" or minus, steel removed, and stockpiled at the facility. All material will remain on site including filtered steel.

- 1. Bid will be for recycling (crushing) of the entire stockpile. Stockpile is assumed to contain 25,000 tons of material.
- 2. The project shall be completed and closed out within 30 calendar days of the "Notice to Proceed".
- 3. The contract will be a lump sum contract. One (1) pay request shall be submitted after final project approval from the owner.

C. SPECIFICATIONS

- Steel to be removed/filtered and remain on site.
- All recycled (crushed) material to remain on site.
- A Density Check/Sampling will be conducted every 2,000 ton by the County Civil Engineer
