To be a valid delivery, sealed bids must be delivered electronic by Central Bidding or in accordance with the specifications and procedures available with Central Bidding, by mail via USPS, by courier service i.e., FedEx or by hand to the Lauderdale County Purchasing Office, 2600 Courthouse Blvd, 2nd Floor, Meridian, MS 39301, during the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday up until 9:00 A.M. on Monday, August 25th.

Bid packets not properly completed will be rejected for failure to comply. Envelopes must be labeled correctly and must be received by the acceptance date and time listed above.

The Lauderdale County Board of Supervisors reserves the right to extend the auction date if necessary to complete the pre-qualification process, amend the specifications, accept, or reject any and/or all bids submitted and to waive informalities.

INFORMATION FOR BIDDERS

This agreement is for a 5-Month Period from September 5, 2025, through January 31, 2026.

All PRICING must be made on the prepared BID form. All blank spaces for the prices must be filled in, in ink or typewritten, and the form must be fully completed and executed when submitted. Only one copy of the BID form is required. Bid Packages may be submitted to the Purchasing manager in a sealed envelope or electronically via Central Bidding at www.centralbidding.com.

BIDDERS must satisfy themselves of the WORK required and the estimated quantities in the Schedule. After PRICING has been submitted, the BIDDER shall not assert that there was a misunderstanding concerning the nature of the WORK to be done.

WORK ORDER shall be issued by the OWNER for each site in which the work is to be accomplished. Pricing shall remain in effect for the period of six (6) months.

The OWNER may make such investigations as he deems necessary to determine the ability of the BIDDER to perform the WORK, and the BIDDER shall furnish to the OWNER all such information and data for this purpose as the OWNER may request. The OWNER reserves the right to reject any BID if the evidence submitted by, or investigation of, such BIDDER fails to satisfy the OWNER that such BIDDER is properly qualified to carry out the obligations of the Agreement and to complete the WORK contemplated therein.

A conditional or qualified BID will not be accepted.

All applicable laws, ordinances, and the rules and regulations of all authorities having jurisdiction over construction of the PROJECT shall apply to the contract throughout.

IN-PLACE ASPHALT PRICING SHEET

The equipment and methods shall comply with the current applicable sections of the latest edition of the Mississippi Department of Transportation's "*Standard Specifications for State aid Road and Bridge Construction.*" The contractor shall provide all equipment and labor necessary to perform base repair as needed and to overlay various county roads. The contractor shall be responsible for the removal, disposal and cleanup of any excavated material in a timely manner. **The proposal quantities noted are NOT proposed for immediate purchase, but rather to establish a unit price for placement of asphalt only. Selection is based on total bid price. Bid on each item is required.** The minimum quantities noted will be the minimum amount of work done for a single mobilization, which shall consist of moving the required personnel and equipment to Lauderdale County. **If there is a delay in response to Lauderdale County's request to pave, Lauderdale County reserves the right of use the next low bidder.**

1. ASPHALT INSTALL FEE: Price per ton **does not** include asphalt. (Asphalt is Owner provided)

Unit Price shall include the following:

- Mobilization
- Hauling of materials from plant to job site within Lauderdale County
- Traffic Control
- Tack applied per project specifications
- Removal, disposal and cleanup of asphalt debris
- 1,000-ton minimum quantity surface course (9.5 mm)

2. ASPHALT BASE REPAIR: Excavate, remove and dispose of failed asphalt and subgrade prior to overlay. Replace base with Base Course Asphalt (ST 19mm) to existing grade and compact as directed by Engineer. Replace subgrade with crushed limestone size no. 610 to existing grade and compact to 95% standard proctor per ASTM D698
