The Lauderdale County Board of Supervisors (County) is soliciting requests for competitive Sealed Bids for one (1) or more Used Commercial Water Trucks meeting/or exceeding the specifications listed within the bid documents.

Each bid must be received in a sealed envelope which is clearly marked on the outside:

After the time and in a designated room and place, the names of the Companies submitting bids will be publicly read. No further information will be read, discussed, or provided until the evaluation of all submittals is completed. From the bids submitted, the Board of Supervisors shall select the most qualified based on price, and other relevant factors, negotiate and enter into a contract, all pursuant to Section 31-7-13, Mississippi Code of 1972, as amended.

The County reserves the right to select the bid which best meets the needs of Lauderdale County.
